## THOMAS DEACON ACADEMY HOME-SCHOOL AGREEMENT

This Home School Agreement lays out the expectations and responsibilities of all parties in supporting the learner to achieve their full potential at Thomas Deacon Academy.

## 1. The Academy will:

- provide a pleasant, safe and well-ordered environment in which students can work and achieve;
- provide a broad and balanced curriculum;
- provide quality learning experiences for all which maximise opportunities for learners to succeed;
- provide regular accurate information concerning students' attendance and academic progress;
- provide regular opportunities for learner progress to be discussed;
- respond constructively to parents' and carers' communications and concerns;
- encourage all members of the Academy community to value the qualities of others and to feel valued themselves;
- set a regular pattern of homework suited to the abilities of each student;
- ensure systems are in place for safe ICT use as described in the IT Acceptable Use Policy;
- tackle any bullying, discrimination, harassment or victimisation.

### 2. As a learner I will:

- take responsibility for my own learning and to ensure that all targets set are met to the best of my ability;
- attend the Academy regularly and be on time;
- follow staff instructions and ensure my behaviour is excellent at all times;
- take pride in my appearance and dress appropriately for the work place in line with the TDA dress code;
- work to the best of my ability, with respect for others;
- complete homework on time;
- maintain a pleasant environment in which to work by keeping it clean, tidy and free from litter;
- treat everyone fairly and with respect;
- let a member of staff know if I have any worries;
- bring the correct equipment to the Academy every day;
- use the Academy's IT systems safely and appropriately;
- NOT bring banned items to the Academy.

# 3. As a parent/carer I will:

- ensure that my child has excellent attendance and punctuality and comes to the Academy properly equipped;
- let the Academy know about concerns or problems that might affect my child's work or behaviour;
- support the Academy's policies and guidelines for behaviour, homework and uniform;
- attend parents' meetings;
- inform the Academy promptly of the reasons for any absence;
- avoid taking my child out of the Academy during the Academy working day;
- only arrange holidays during published Academy holidays.
